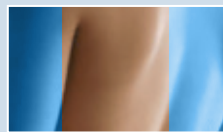

Hamburg is always worth a visit! I am delighted to invite you to the 19th Annual Meeting of the German Spine Society in the North of Germany. After 2011, the Annual Meeting will take place for the second time in the Hanseatic city, in the modernised CCH – Congress Center Hamburg, from 27 to 29 November 2024.

The motto of the Annual Meeting is “Spine between clinical experience and artificial intelligence”. It is supposed to put emphasise on the pressure our clinical work cannot run from, and that other knowledge-based areas of science have to face too.

The application of artificial intelligence in everyday clinical practice and in research will be a focal point, alongside degenerative diseases, registers, recording complications and the presentation of currently available robotic systems. In Hamburg, we will also focus on professional policy issues such as Employee recruitment and retention and the effects of the Hospital Reform Act on future work in spinal surgery.

In order to address the diverse challenges of everyday life in the OR and at the same time the importance of effective cooperation, next year’s nursing and therapist conference will be given special emphasis. The nursing conference, or in contemporary terms: the conference of the anaesthesia and OR functional services, will take place on Thursday.

Of course, the social aspects of our Annual Meeting will not be neglected in Hamburg either, with the DWG Party Night organised by the Young Forum and the Social Evening.
